Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn inhabitants of the Dighton Water District in the Town of Dighton who are qualified to vote at District meetings therein, to meet in the Dighton Middle School Gymnasium in said Town of Dighton on Thursday, May 27, 2021 at 7:00P.M. to take action on the following articles, viz:

ARTICLE 1 To choose a moderator to preside over said meeting.

ARTICLE 2 To hear the reports of the Officers and to act thereon.

ARTICLE 3 To act relative to the establishing of salaries of the elected officers in accordance with Section 108 and 108B, Chapter 41, of the General Laws.

Raise and Appropriate

ARTICLE 4 To act relative to the required bonding of the Treasurer in accordance with Section 121, Chapter 41, of the General Laws.

ARTICLE 5 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate and/or transfer from available funds in the Treasury the sum of money for the redemption of District Bonds and Notes becoming due in the year ending June 30, 2022, and to pay the interest on District Debt or take any other action thereon.

Raise and Appropriate

ARTICLE 6 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate and/or transfer from available funds in the treasury, the sum of money necessary to defray District charges and assessments for the year ending June 30, 2022 as approved by Commissioners of the District or take any other action thereon.

ARTICLE 7 To see if the voters will authorize the Treasurer with the approval of the Commissioners, to borrow from time to time in anticipation of the revenue for the year ending June 30, 2022 in accordance with the General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 4, and Acts in Amendment thereof, and including in addition thereto, Chapter 849 of the Acts of 1969, as amended, and to issue a note or notes therefor payable within one year and to renew any notes as may be given for a period of less than one (1) year in accordance with Section 17, Chapter 44, of the General Laws.

ARTICLE 8 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for the District's Reserve Account for the Fiscal Year

ending June 30, 2022, said monies to be expended from said Reserve Account by approval of the Dighton Water District Finance Committee, or act thereon.

ARTICLE 9 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for the District's Webmaster, or act thereon.

\$4,510.00 Raise and Appropriate

ARTICLE 10 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for testing, maintenance, repair, and/or upgrading of water meters, or act thereon.

\$70,000.00 Raise and Appropriate

ARTICLE 11 To see if the District will raise and appropriate a sum of money to perform a Valve Exercise Program and Repairs, or act thereon.

\$3,500.00 Raise and Appropriate

ARTICLE 12 To see if the District will raise and appropriate a sum of money to perform an Emergency Response Plan Update or act thereon.

\$14,900.00 Raise and Appropriate

ARTICLE 13 To see if the District will raise and appropriate \$24,000.00 for renovations to the Dighton Water District Treatment Plant offices, or act thereon.

\$24,000.00 Raise and Appropriate

ARTICLE 14 To see if the District will vote to appropriate a sum of money for the replacement of the Main Street water main, said project to include replacement of existing cast iron water main with ductile iron water main, replacement of hydrants, gate valves, and water services; to determine whether this appropriation shall be raised by borrowing from the Massachusetts Clean Water Trust or otherwise; and to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 15 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate and/or transfer from available funds in the treasury, the sum of money necessary to perform a Field Survey for the Main Street Water Main Replacement project or act thereon.

\$265,000.00 Raise and Appropriate

ARTICLE 16 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money to have a Maintenance Contractor provide services to replace approximately 800 Meter Interface Units that are under warrant and to replace approximately 400 analog meters with digital read meters, or act thereon.

\$120,000.00 Raise and Appropriate

ARTICLE 17 To see if the District will vote to amend "Article VI Section 6 Right of Entry" of the District's General Bylaws in its entirety and to replace it as follows, or act thereon.

Article VI

Section 6: Right of Entry

Owners or occupants of any commercial, industrial or residential premises served by the Dighton Water District shall allow entry to their premises without a warrant for the purpose of inspecting and surveying their water system for new installations or cross connections or to remove, repair or replace any water meter at any time the District deems necessary. When access is refused, the water shall be shut off and not turned on until

such access has been allowed and fees have been paid for shutting off and turning on the water.

ARTICLE 18 To recognize and reward outstanding citizen contributions of time, talent or resources to the mission of the Dighton Water District, or act thereon.


ARTICLE 19 To transact such other business as may legally come before said meeting.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up attested copies thereof in two or more public places in various sections of the District 7 days at least before the day and time set for said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to the District Clerk at the time and place of holding said meeting.


